**Pfizer Helpful Answers** is a family of assistance programs for the uninsured and underinsured who need help getting Pfizer medicines. The programs listed below are the ones most likely to be appropriate for patients in need of assistance with primary care medicines.

### Free Pfizer Medicines:



Provides free medicines at the doctor's office\*

#### ELIGIBILITY:

- Have no prescription coverage
- Meet the income guidelines†
- Live in the US, Puerto Rico, or the US Virgin Islands

#### HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL ROLE:

- Let your patients know about the program
- Complete the healthcare professional section on the program application
- Remind patients to complete the application and mail it in with required documents (proof of income)
- Distribute medicines—a 90-day‡ supply will be delivered to your office\*
- Reordering medicines for patients is simple—just call 1-866-706-2400



MAINTAIN™ is a program that helps eligible people in financial need continue to get their Pfizer medicines for free up to a year or until they get insured, whichever comes first, if they became unemployed on or after 1/1/09 and do not have prescription coverage. Applications for MAINTAIN will be accepted through 12/31/09.

\* Home delivery only in Puerto Rico and the US Virgin Islands.

† Lower-income patients with prescription coverage may still be eligible for assistance if they are experiencing significant financial or medical hardship.

‡ Not a 90-day supply in all cases.

### Medicines at a Savings:



Provides savings at the pharmacy counter

#### ELIGIBILITY:

- Have no prescription coverage
- Live in the US, Puerto Rico, or the US Virgin Islands

#### HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL ROLE:

- Let your patients know they could save on their Pfizer medicines by applying
- There are no further steps for you—just let your patients know that they can complete and mail the application on their own
